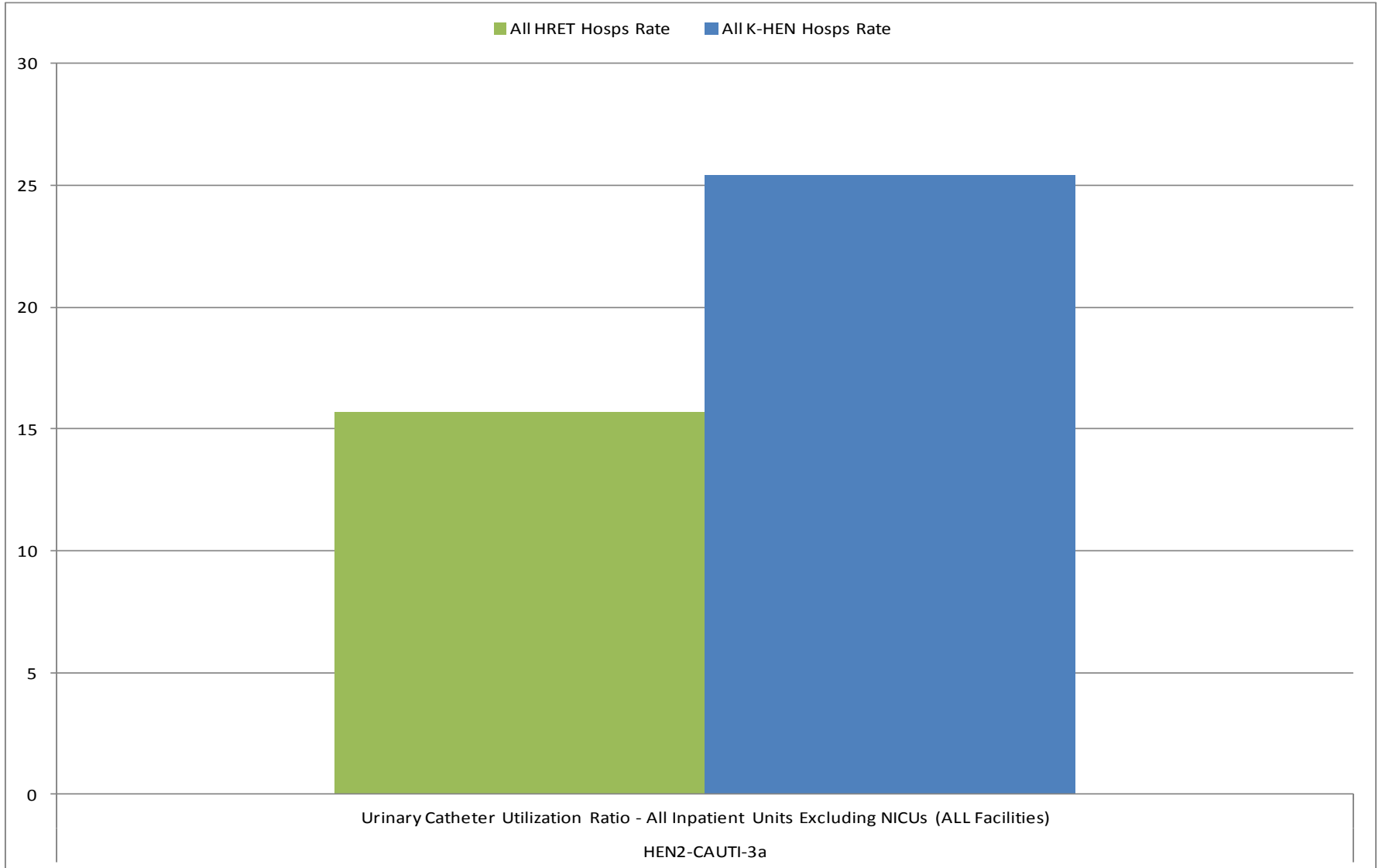

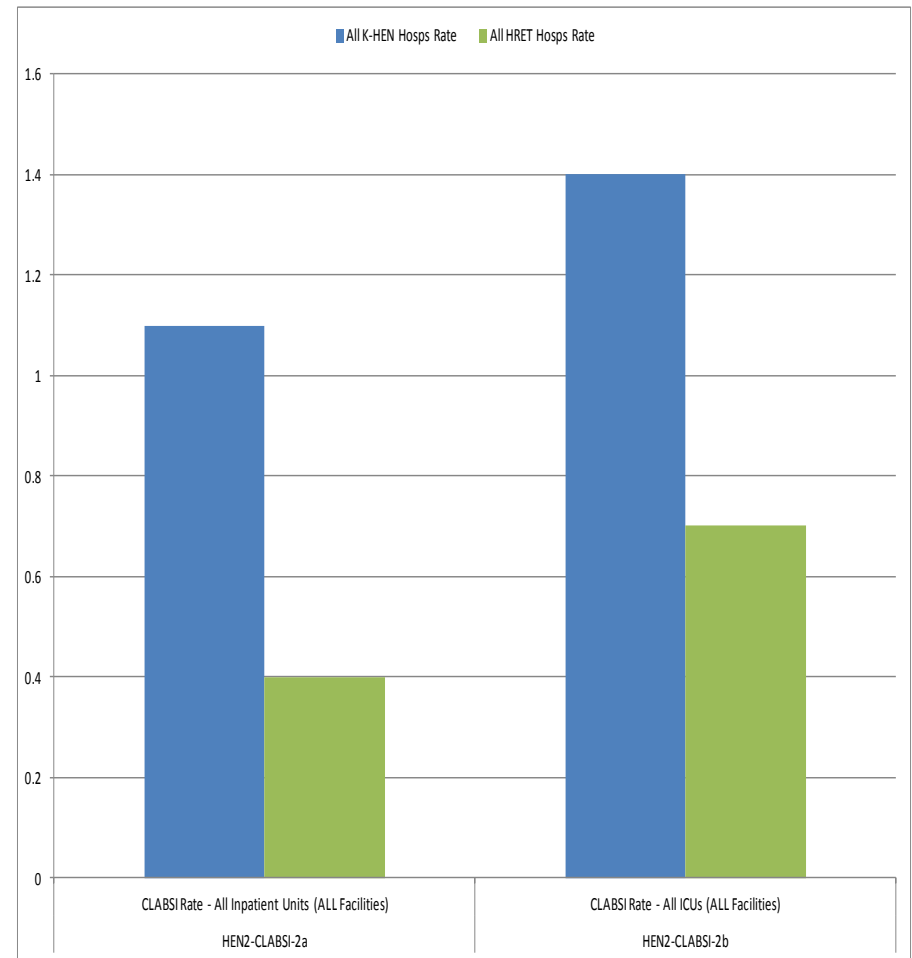
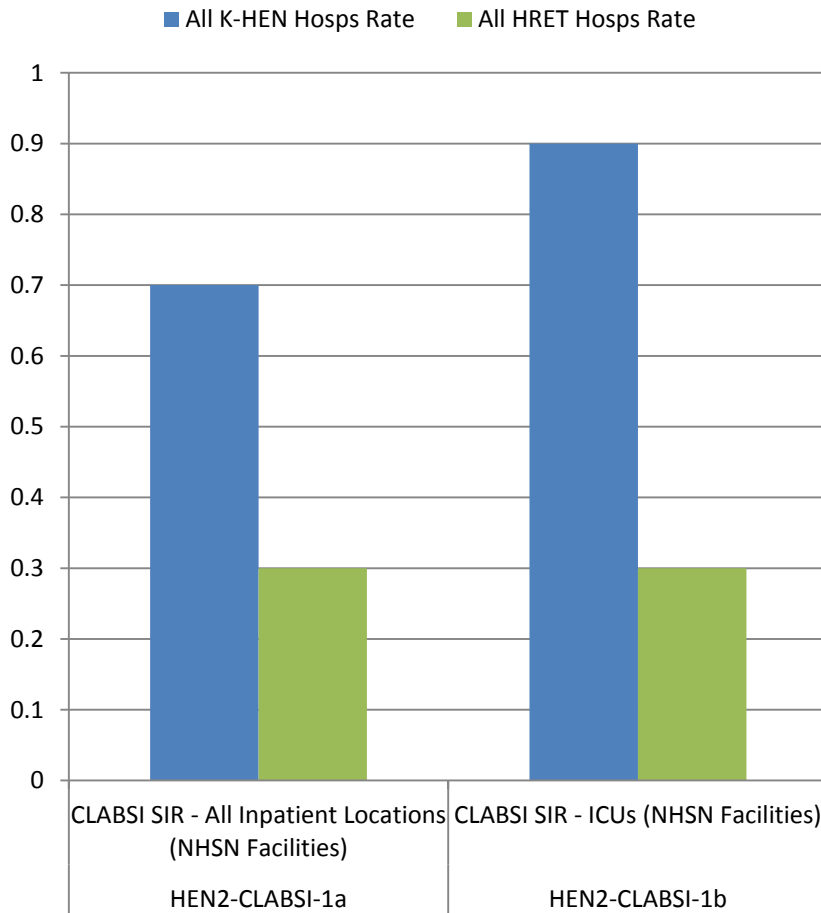
CAUTI SIR and Rate



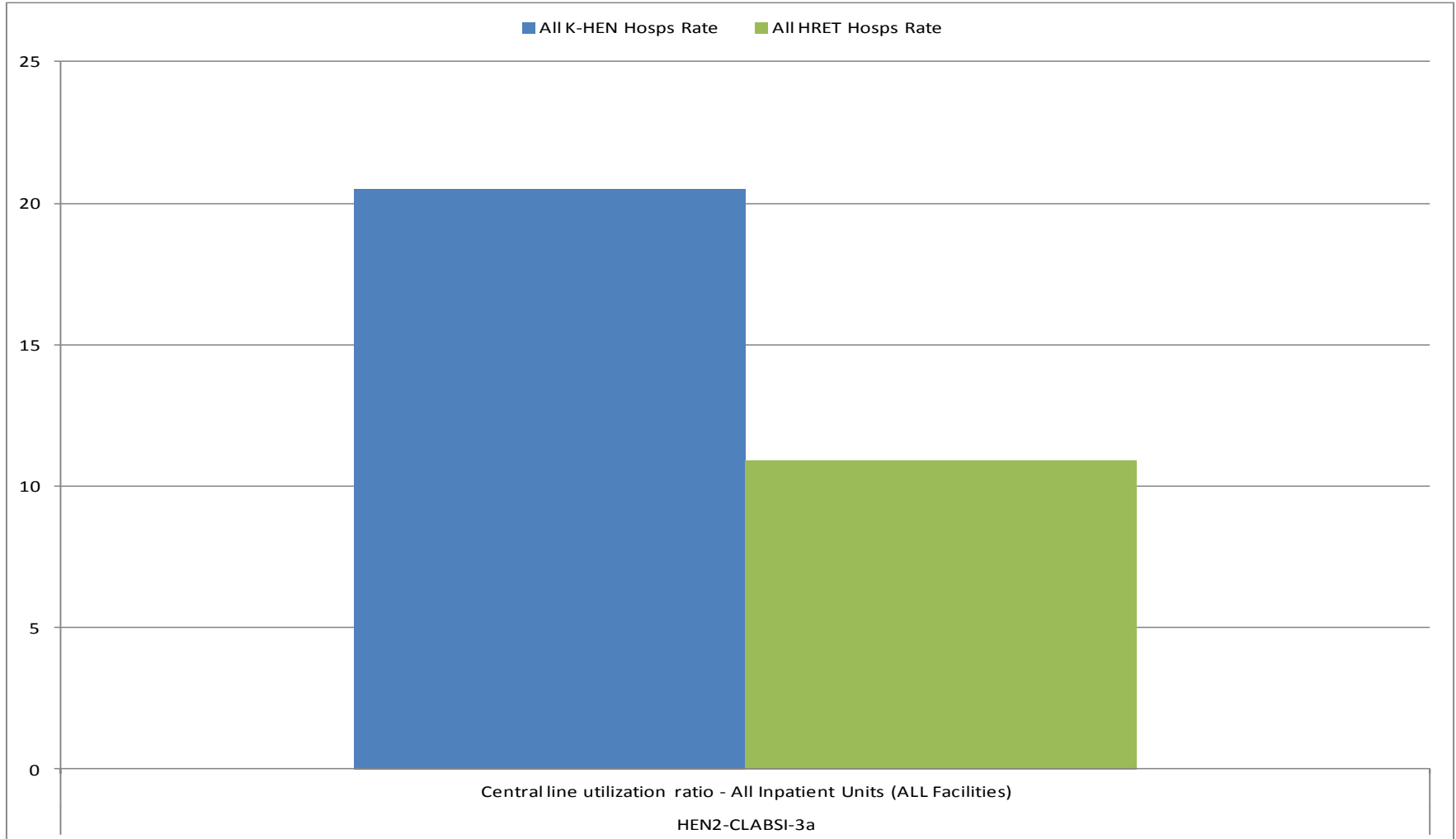
CAUTI Utilization Ratio



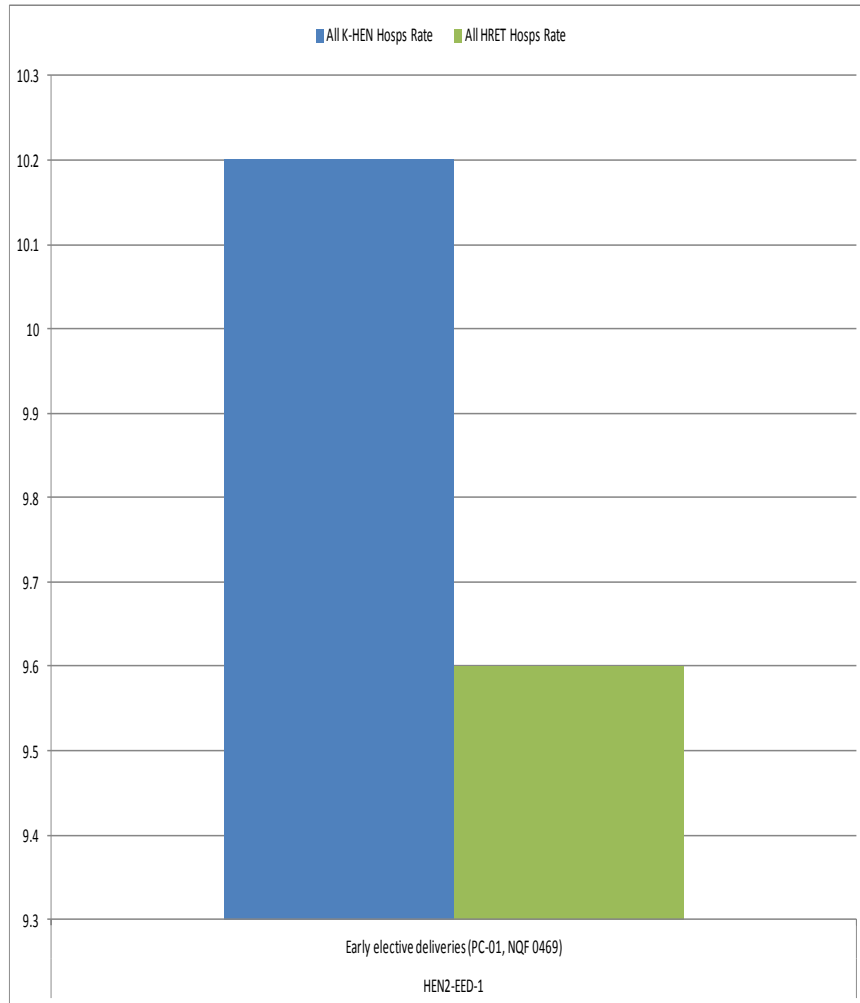
CLABSI SIR and Rate



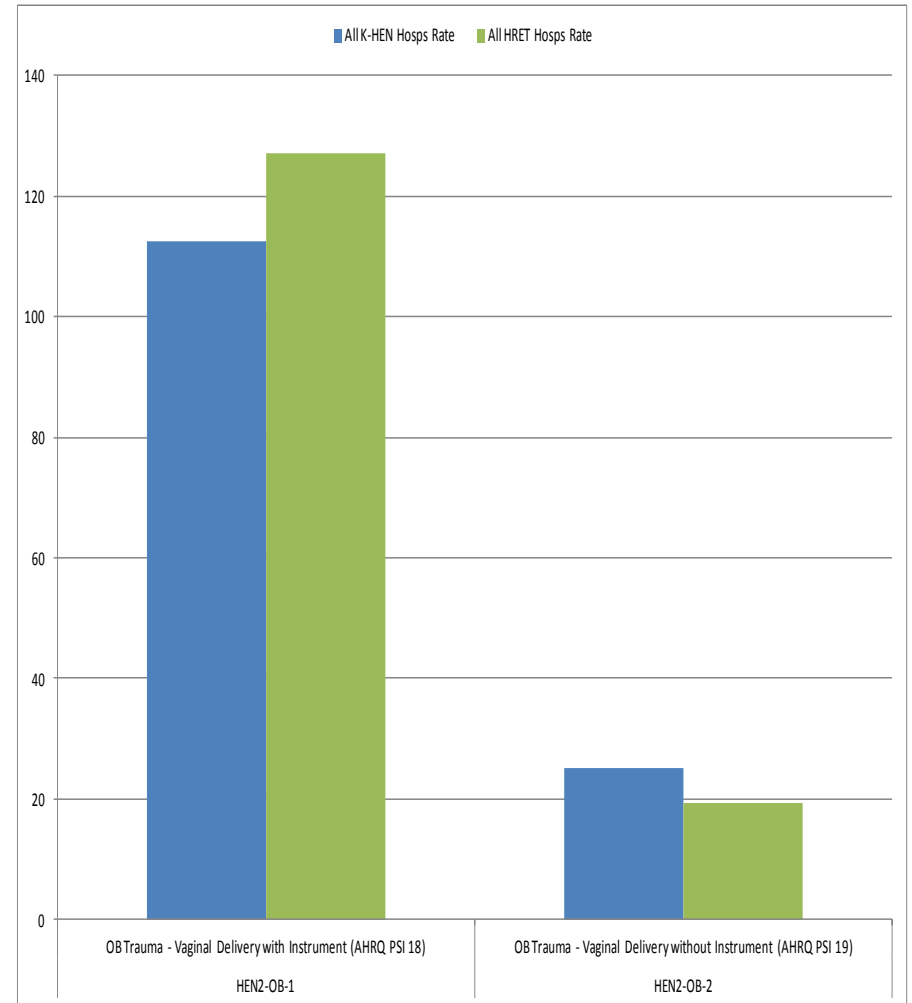
CLABSI Utilization Ratio



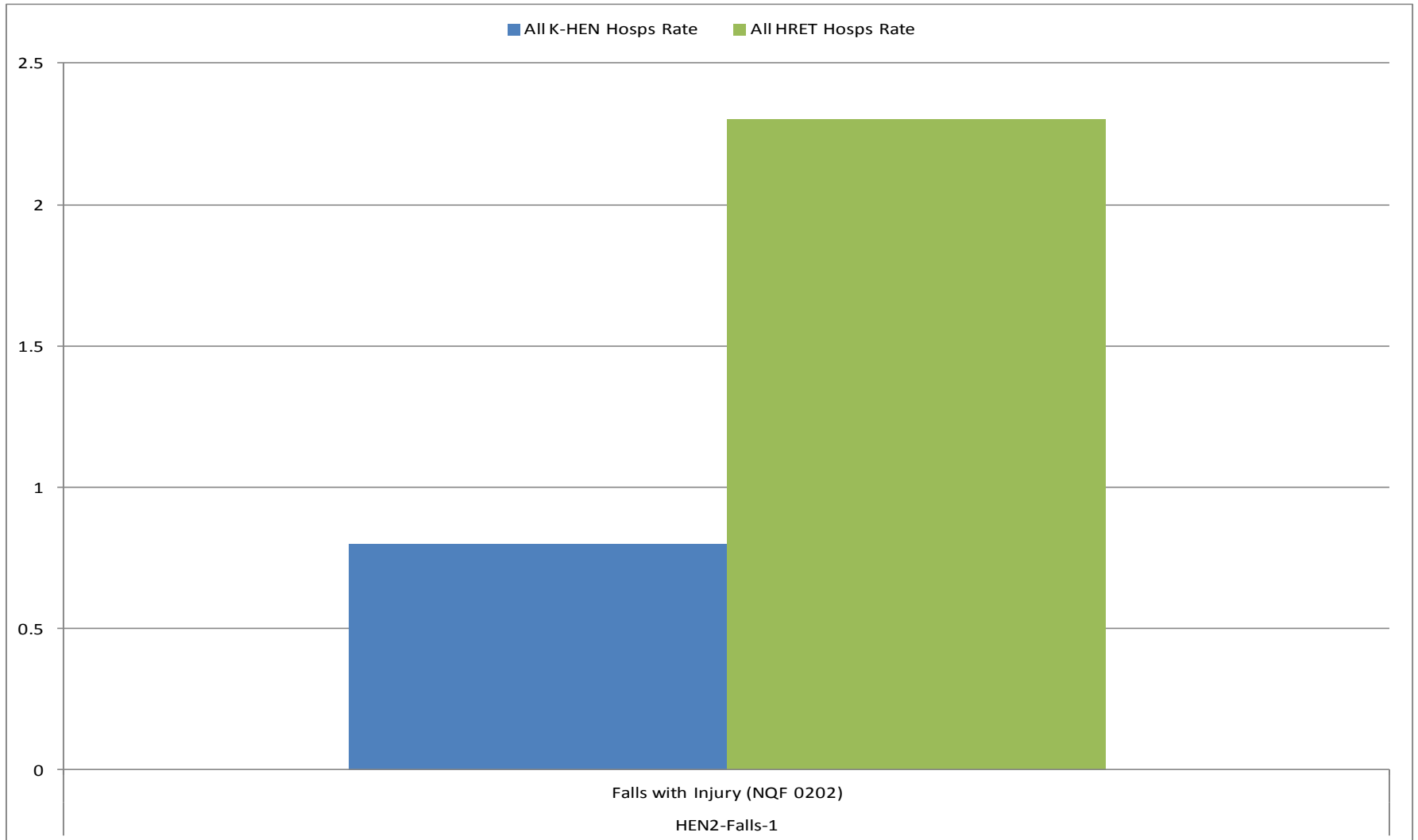
Early Elective Delivery 2013



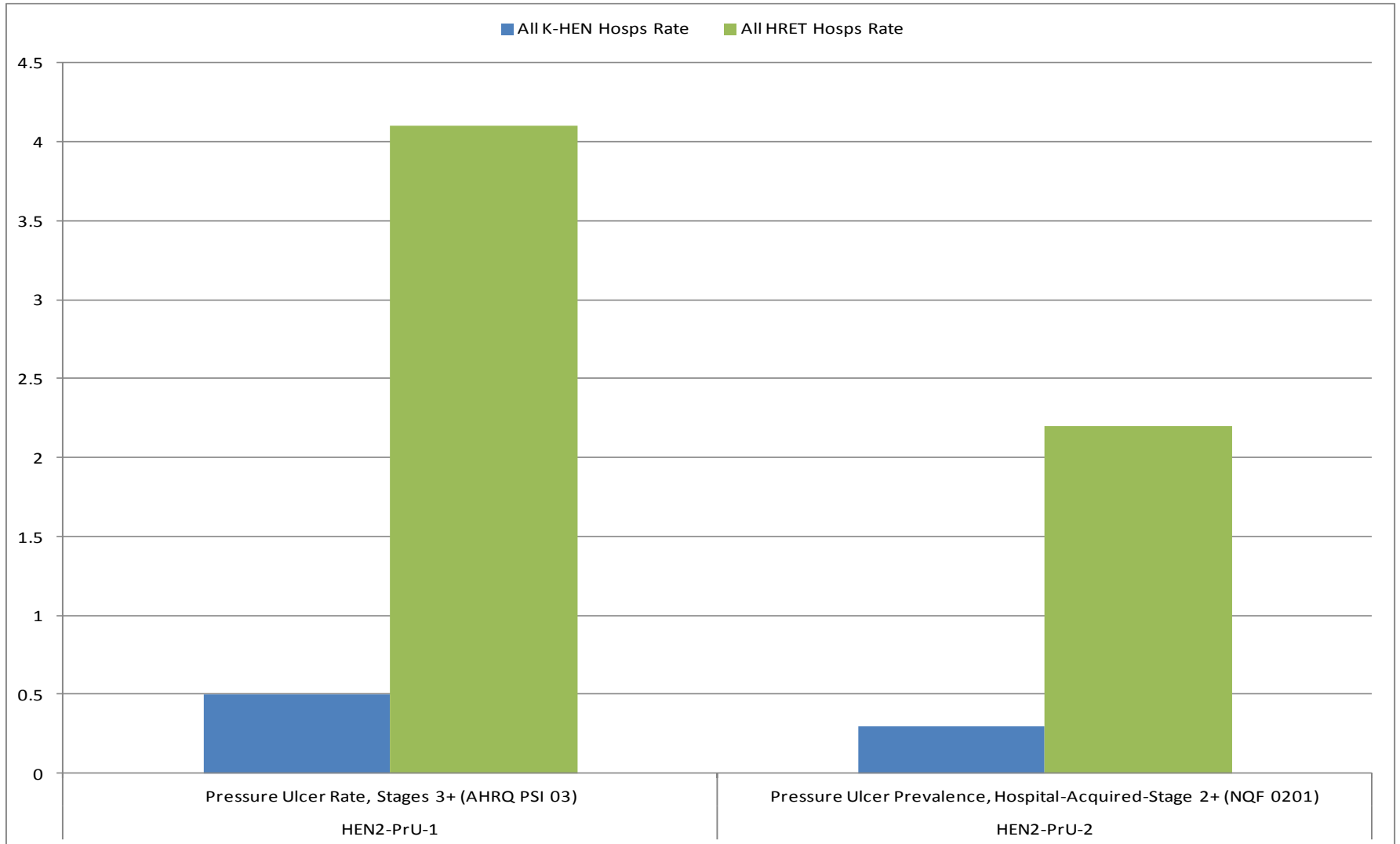

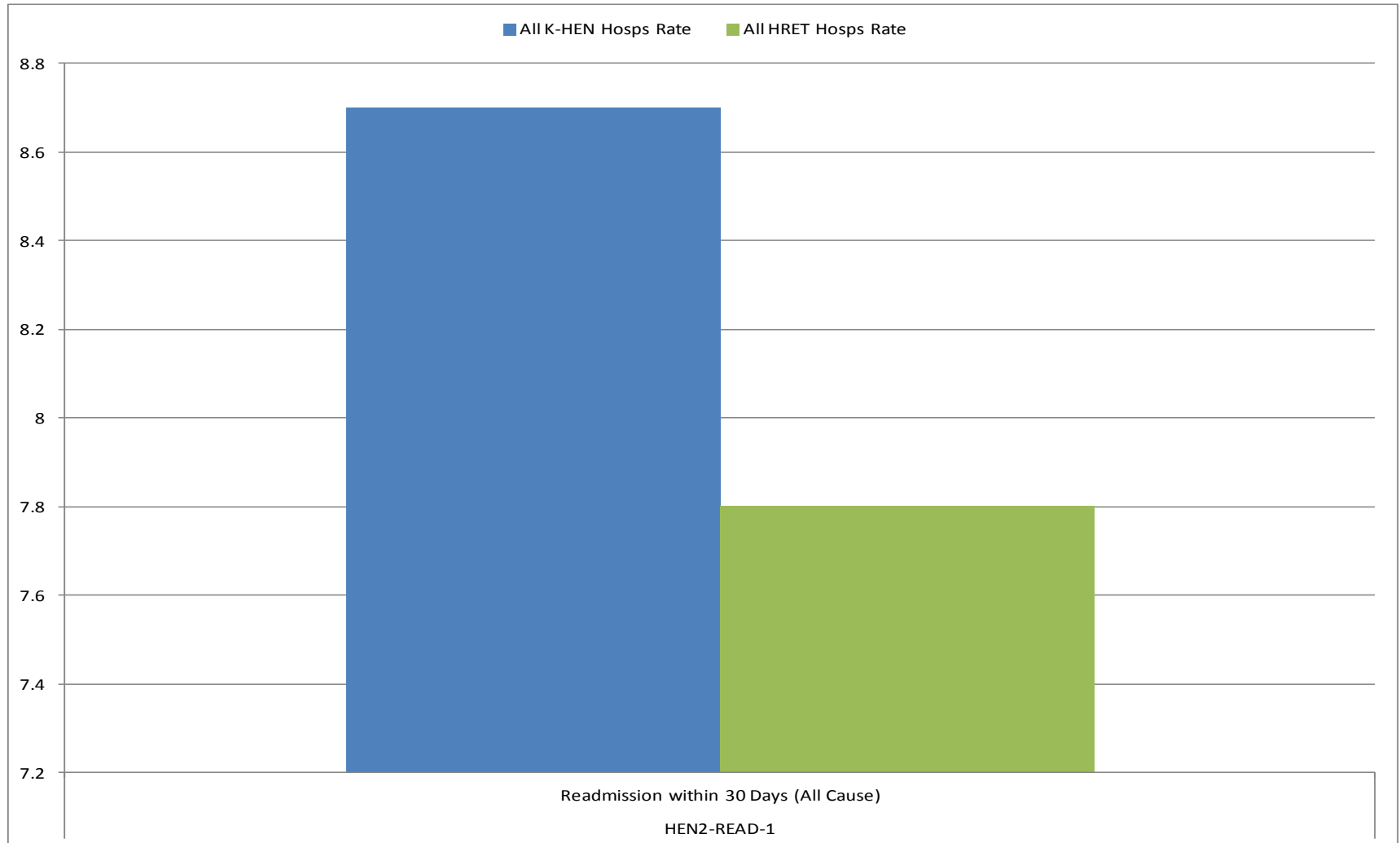
Falls With Injury



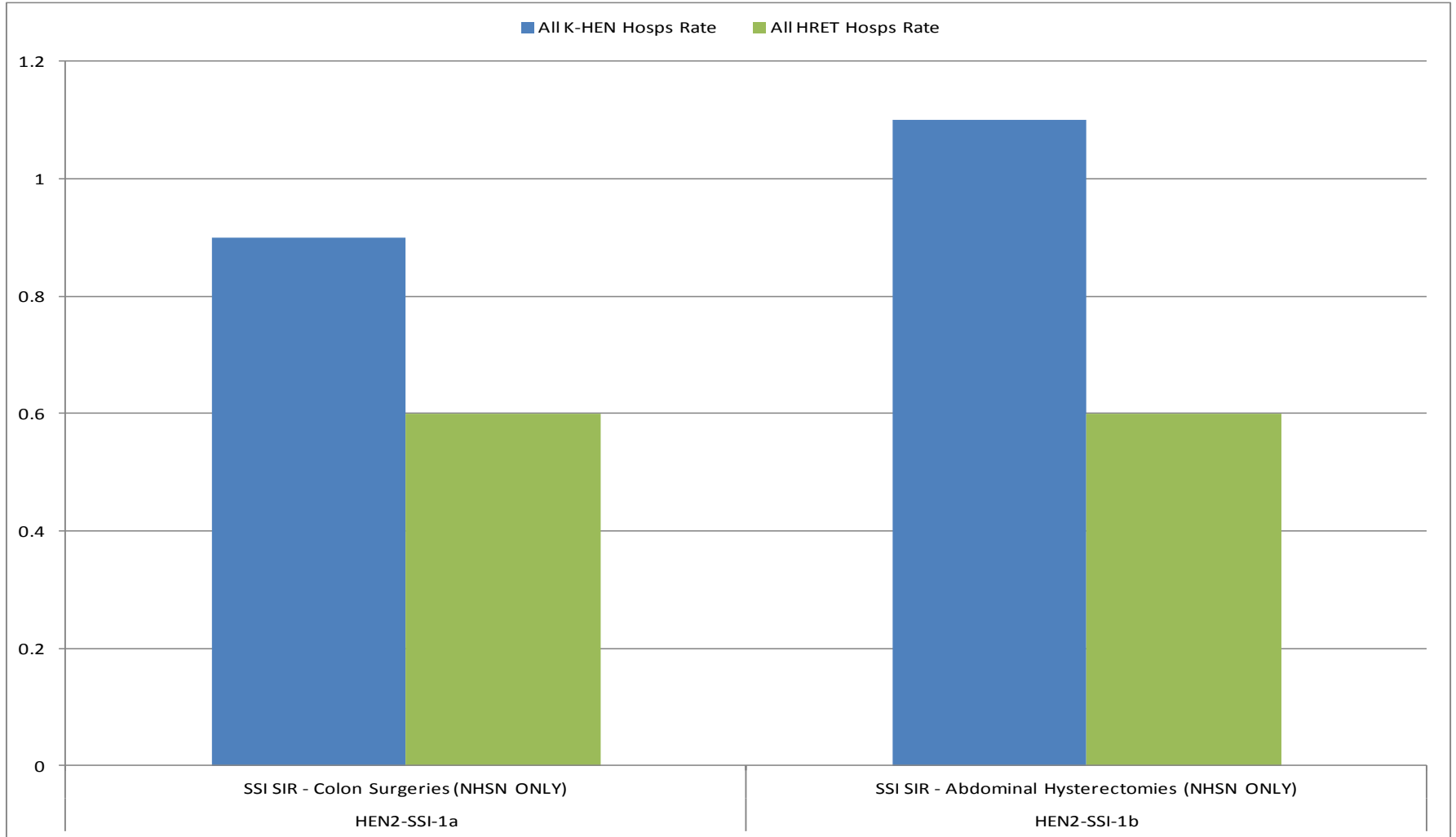
Pressure Ulcer



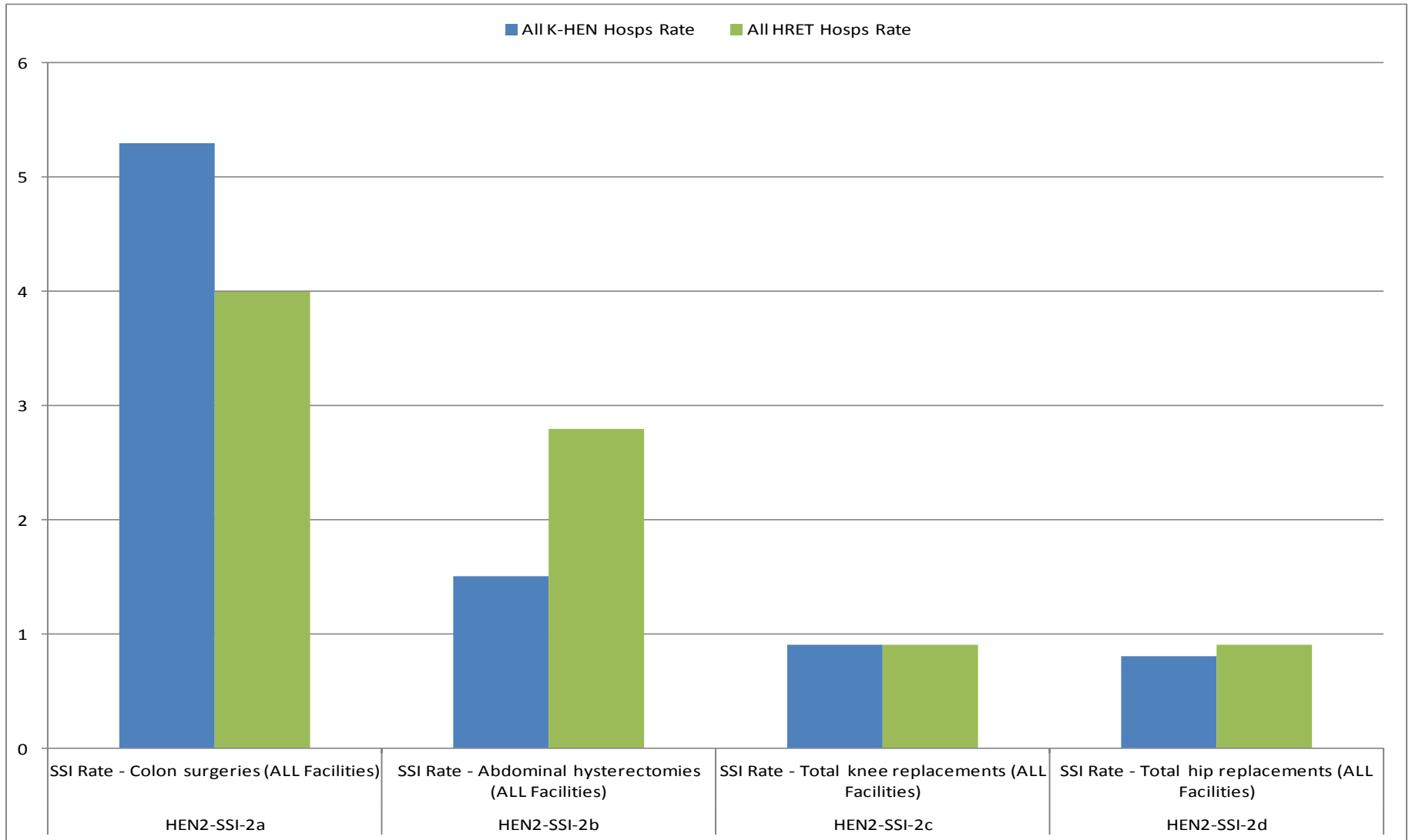
HW 30 Day All Cause Readmissions



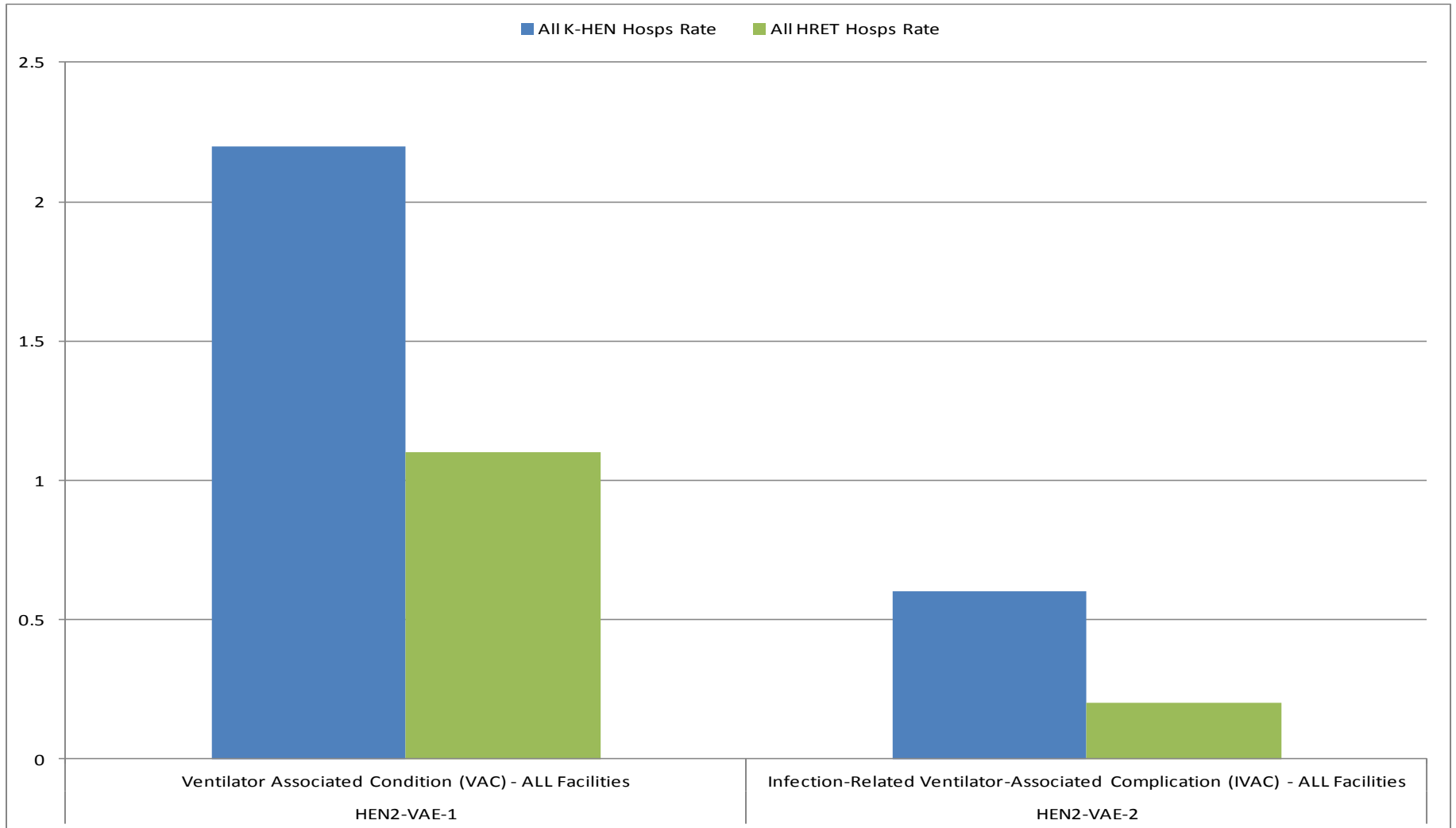
SSI SIR – Colon/Abdominal Hysterectomy



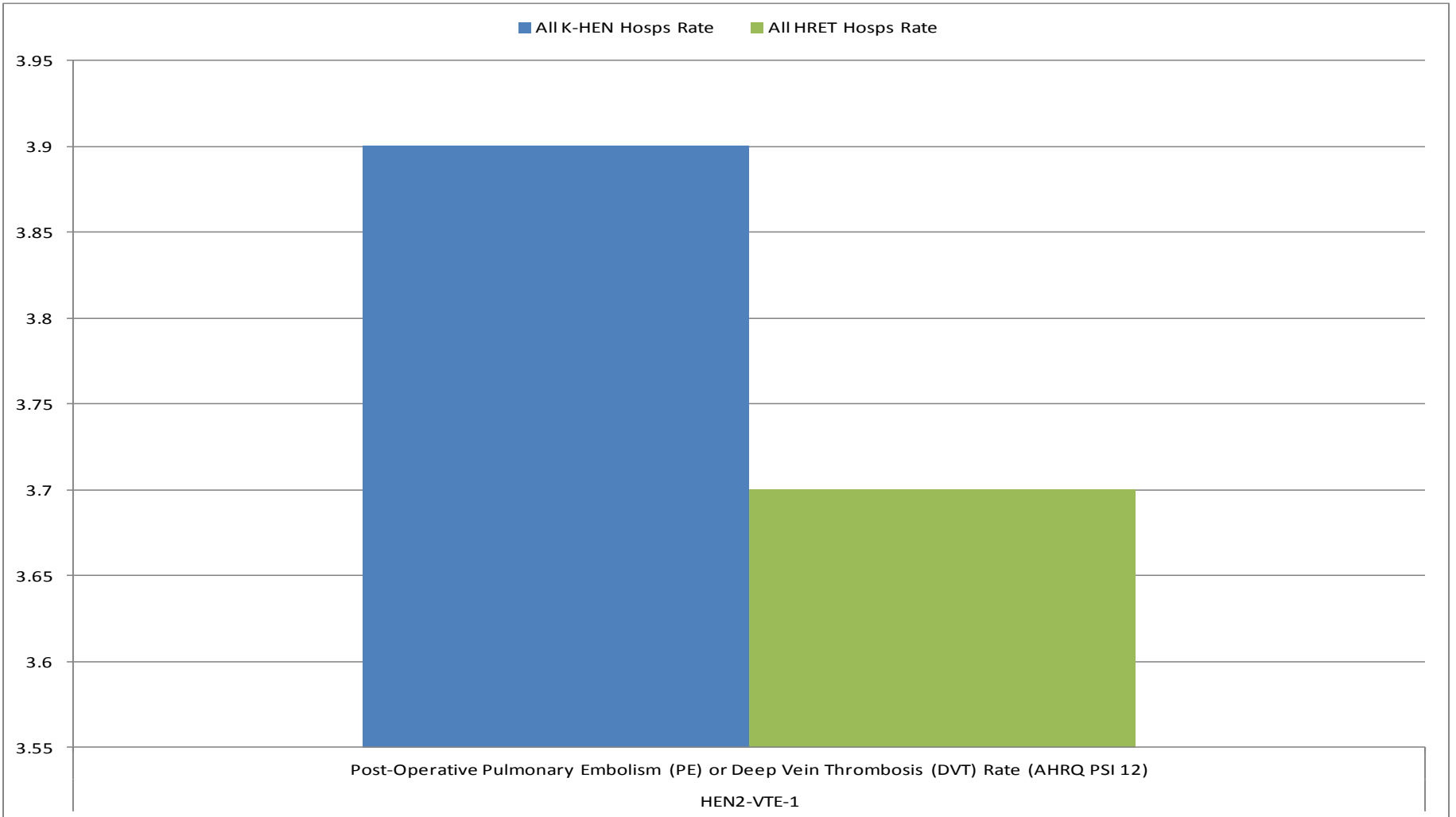
SSI Rates



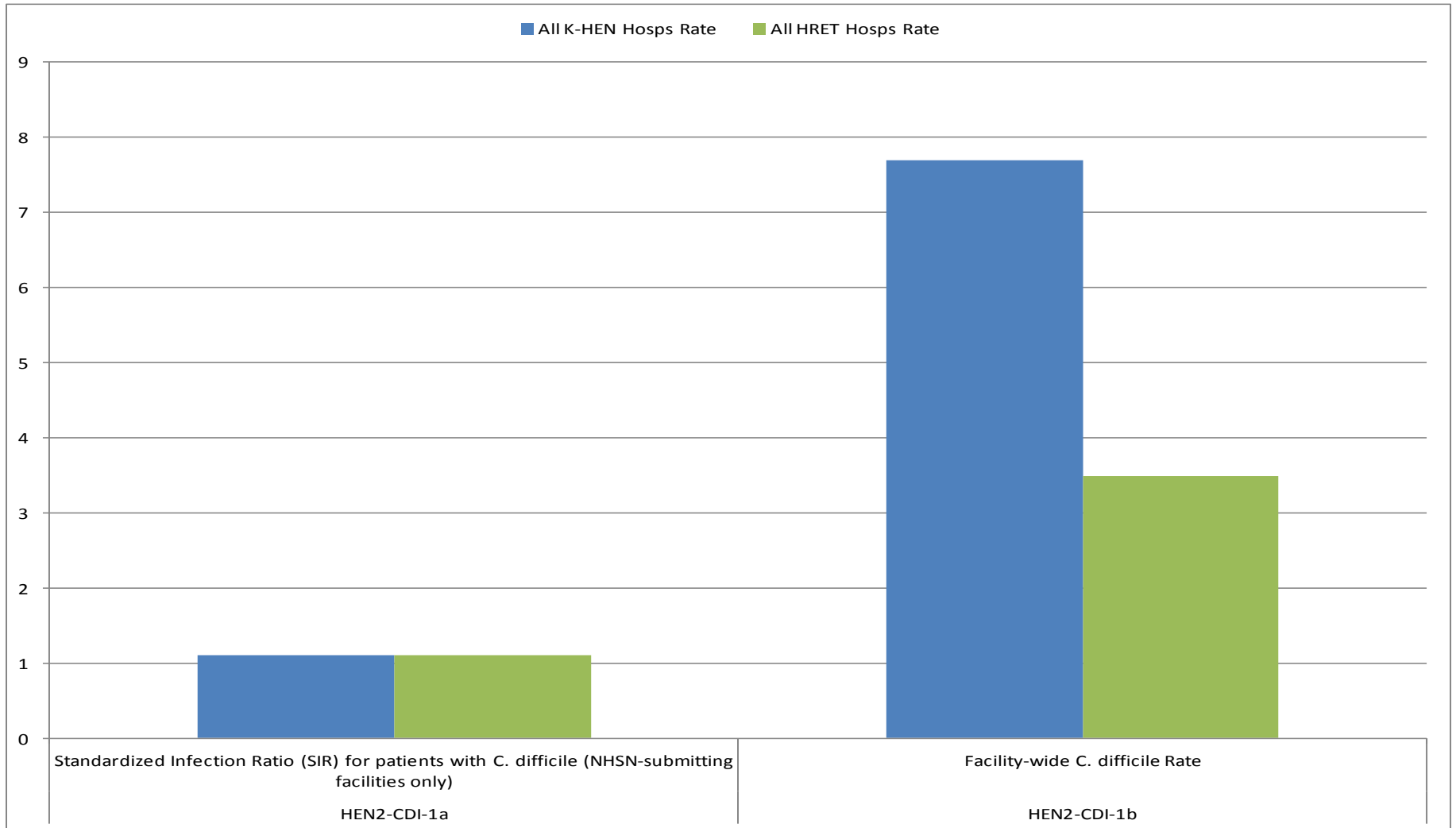

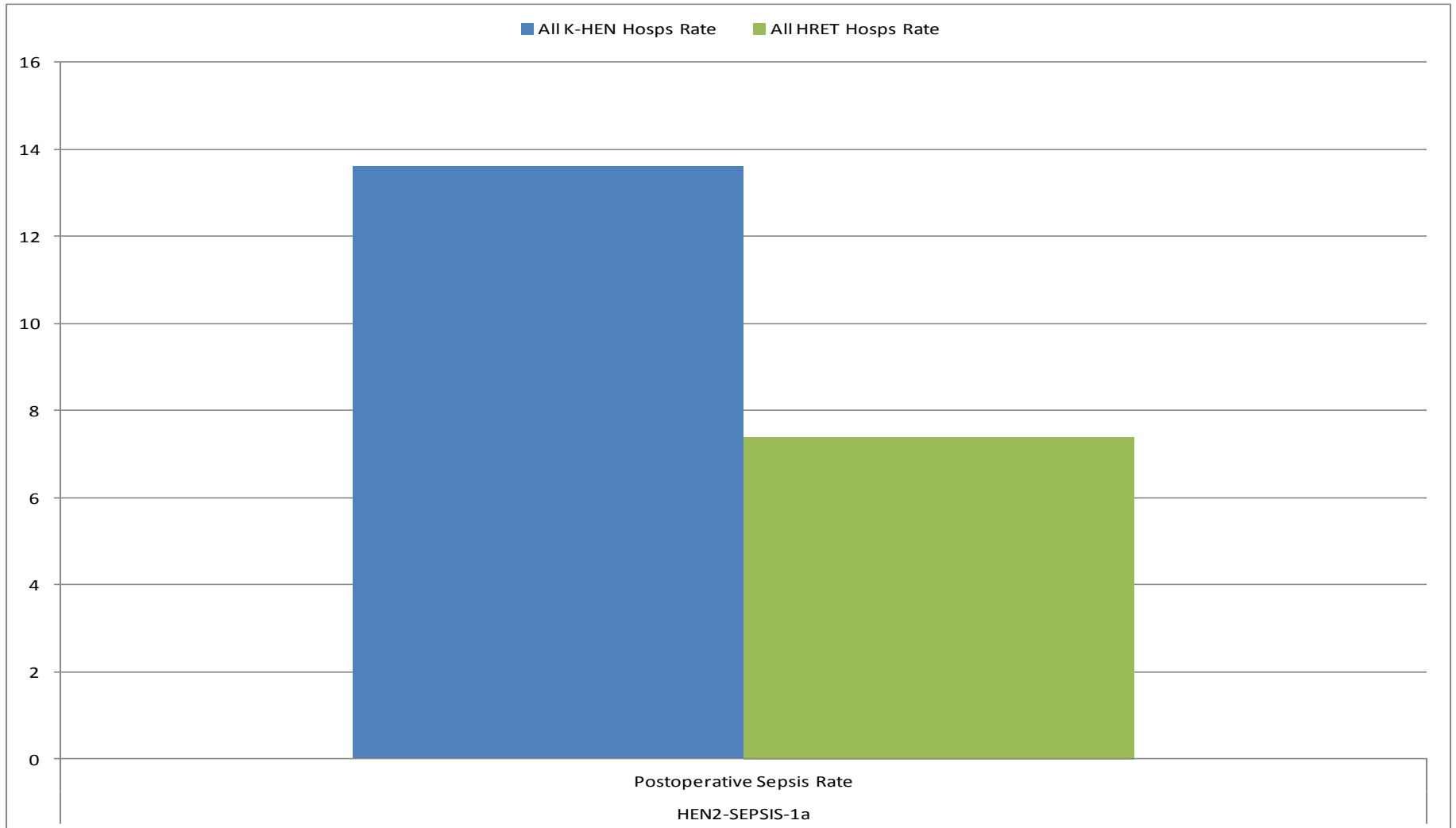
VTE

Data – Incentive Updates

- Milestone 1 - 74 hospitals received \$500 for participation (to offset additional data work), totaling \$37,000 to Kentucky Hospitals
- Milestone 2 – 51 hospitals to receive \$500 for submitting baseline data by deadline, totaling \$25,500 to Kentucky hospitals
